Guidelines and Recommendations for Resuming In-Person Worship Services Implementation May 31, 2020

The State has authorized the resumption of in-person worship services, contingent on the implementation and observation of safety practices. This is a summary of those guidelines. These guidelines will be in effect for 21 days (through June 14) and re-evaluated after that.

The guidelines divide into three primary areas.

- 1) Staff Training on how COVID19 spreads and how to prevent it from spreading.
- 2) Site-specific plan for preparing and managing the facility.
- 3) Worship-specific plan for managing congregant activities.

Resumption of in-person meetings will require each church to produce and implement their own unique plan! Each church will need to adapt the safety practices to their facilities and activities.

Staff Training:

- 1. Each staff and volunteer must read the summary of the Center for Disease Control's "Understanding and Preventing COVID19" document and sign the acknowledgment.
- 2. Key points:
 - a. COVID19 is a <u>respiratory</u> disease: it infects the lungs and spreads mostly through the nose and mouth.
 - b. Staff are required to self-screen themselves for temperature and symptoms
 - c. Basic prevention includes
 - i. Frequent hand-washing
 - ii. Use a face covering
 - iii. Physical distancing
 - iv. Stay home if you are sick.
- 3. Each church will need to prepare their own Site Plan and Worship Plan (see ideas below) and have each staff and volunteer read and acknowledge the plan.

Develop a Site-Specific Plan for preparing and managing the facility

- 1. Attendance in CA is limited to 25% of building capacity, or 100 persons, whichever is less. NV is 50 persons.
- 2. Provide hand-sanitization stations and signage (w/ the four prevention practices above.)
- 3. Screen attendees for fever or symptoms (a forehead thermometer will be helpful.)
- 4. Re-arrange the seating to allow for physical distancing between family units.
- 5. Tape off unused areas.
- 6. Frequent cleaning of high-touch surfaces.
- 7. Block-open or hold-open all possible doors.
- 8. Remove or block any touch items in the lobby (brochure racks, drinking fountains, etc.)
- 9. No food or coffee service.

Worship-Specific Activities

- 1. Children must sit with their family—DA churches should not provide separate children's services.
- 2. Require all participants to wear a mask.
- 3. Eliminate all personal touch activity (hand shaking, hand-holding, hugging, etc.).

- 4. Eliminate all items that are passed by hand: communion trays, offering plates, bulletins, etc.
- 5. No sharing of microphones, instruments, pulpit, etc.
- 6. Limit singing (absolutely no singing without a mask).
- 7. Recommend shorter services and multiple services.
- 8. Recommend dismissal by rows.
- 9. Discourage congregating in the building (ask people to socialize outside the building.)
