## California: Changes starting June 15, 2021.

Governor Newsom has announced that California will "fully re-open" on June 15, 2021. (A Federal Court already mandated most of these items, but let's review anyway.)

What does this mean for our churches?

- 1. No capacity restrictions.
- 2. No physical distancing restrictions.
- 3. No singing restrictions.
- 4. Masks: The State requires unvaccinated individuals to mask when indoors, unless they qualify for an exception.
- 5. Enforcement: The State allows the host to choose between three options:
  - a. Require all patrons to wear masks.
  - b. Ask unmasked people to verify their vaccination status.
  - c. Post a notice about the requirement and allow people to self-attest that they are compliant. (Leave it to them.)

## Nevada: Restrictions as of as of June 15, 2021.

Most counties have eliminated the social distancing/capacity restrictions. Clark County is 80%. (This restriction applies to all businesses in Clark County, and therefore survives the Federal Court ruling of May 17.)

The statewide mask mandate is effect in all counties.
